2.	<p><u>Revision of Curriculum & CCA Time due to reinstatement of P1 & P2 Programme for Active Learning (PAL)</u></p> <p>(I) Reinstatement of P1 and P2 PAL Programme PAL programme is an important programme through which P1 and P2 students gain exposure and experiences that facilitate their holistic development in the physical, cognitive, social, aesthetics and moral domains. With COVID-19 measures eased in Phase 3, the school is reinstating the PAL programme.</p> <p>(II) Revision of Curriculum Time In view of the safe management measures, staggered dismissal will continue to be enforced.
