Since its inauguration in 2007, AGAB has recognised a total of 64 outstanding primary, secondary and pre-university Malay Language teachers. This year marks AGAB's 15th year.</p> <p>AGAB 2021 is jointly organised by the Malay Language Council, Singapore (MLCS), the Malay Language Teachers' Association (PGBM), Berita Harian (BH) and the Malay Language Learning and Promotion Committee (MLLPC).</p> <p>We would like to invite parents to nominate outstanding Malay Language teachers from the school who are eligible and deserving of the award. The first application period for 2021 is from 1 March 2021, 9am to 12 March 2021, 4pm.</p> <p>In cases where parents require school's assistance to administer the ad-hoc transfer application forms (e.g. parents without SingPass, legal guardians, foster parents, grandparents or guardians caring for the students who are unable to apply online), the completed forms would need to be ready before 12 March 2021, 4pm.</p>	ST1 and 3
