5.	<p><b><u>Student Leadership Training</u></b></p> <p><u>P1 &amp; P2 Students</u> The school will be conducting student leadership training for our P1 and 2 students to inculcate leadership attitudes and hone our students' leadership skills. Details are as follows:</p> <p><b>a) P1 leadership training (26 April for 5 classes, 30 April for 4 classes)</b> Monday 26 April: 1 Respect 1 Responsibility 1 Care 1 Integrity 1 Motivation Friday 30 April: 1 Resilience 1 Harmony 1 Discipline 1 Gratitude</p> <p>Objectives: To</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>instill the idea that a leader need not be exceptional. Anyone can be a leader.</li> <li>build confidence in students that they too can be a leader</li> <li>teach that leadership is about influence. If you can influence someone for the better, you are a leader.</li> </ol> <p><b>b) P2 leadership training (29 April for all classes)</b></p> <p>Objectives: To</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>teach students the character traits of a good leader.</li> <li>link the character traits of a good leader to school values</li> </ol> <p>Both programmes cost \$18.00. The school will be subsidising \$6.00 for each P1 and P2 student. Details are as follows:</p> <p><b>a) P3 leadership training (30 April, 2.15pm to 4.15pm)</b></p> <p>Objectives:To</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) learn presentation skills</li><li>2) articulate ideas to an audience</li></ol> <p>This is a mandatory programme for all P3 students. The programme costs \$15.00. The school will be subsidising \$6.00 for each P3 student. The remaining balance of \$9.00 will be deducted either through Student Edusave account (for SCs) or Giro/Cash (for SPR and IS) as indicated in the School Bill which was issued to parents and guardians previously.</p> <p>Please ensure that your child has sufficient money for lunch. Please also make the necessary arrangements for your child to go home after the programme. There will be no school bus services provided for afternoon enrichment classes.</p> <p><b>b) P4 leadership training (7 May, 2.15pm to 4.15pm)</b></p> <p>Objectives:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1) To learn conflict management skills</li></ol> <p>The programme costs \$20.00. The school will be subsidising \$6.00 for each P4 student. The remaining balance of \$14.00 will be deducted either through Student Edusave account (for Singapore Citizens) or Giro/Cash (for Singapore Permanent Residents and International Students) as indicated in the School Bill which was issued to parents and guardians previously.</p> <p>This is a mandatory programme for all P4 students. Please ensure that your child has sufficient money for lunch. Please also make the necessary arrangements for your child to go home after the programme. There will be no school bus services provided for afternoon enrichment classes.</p> <p>For P3 and P4 parents, we will be sending a separate Parents Gateway notification for you to indicate your acknowledgement and dismissal details for your child.</p>
