We encourage your child/ward to join us on Zoom with you to share his/her reflection of his/her learning progress and support he/she might need. The conversation will begin with a sharing on a piece of assignment/task filed in his/her Portfolio File. Prior to PCTC, the subject teachers would have prompted your child/ward to reflect on the following:</p> <p>(a) Which is the piece of work you are most proud of? (b) Which is the piece of work you have made improvement? (c) What will you do now to further improve? (d) How can we (teacher and parents) help you?
