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

3	<p><u>Use of School Smart cards for Concessionary Travel – Primary 1 students</u></p> <p>Primary 1 students will receive their School Smart Cards (SSC) this week. Parents are advised to check the photo and details printed on the card upon receipt of you child’s SSC. Please inform the school immediately if there is any discrepancy.</p> <p>For students who had their photos taken during the reshoot or had submitted softcopy photos, their SSCs will be printed in the supplementary issue. The supplementary issue will be delivered to schools at a later date.</p> <p>Primary 1 students can continue to use their Child Concession Card which entitles them to travel for free until 30 April 2022.</p> <p>To start using the SSCs for concessionary travel from May 2022, students are required to activate their SSCs at the TransitLink (TL) Ticket Office, TL Concession Card Replacement Office (CCRO) or Passenger Services Centre (PSC) located at MRT stations or bus interchanges by toping-up the value for the card.</p> <p>Cash top-up at the PSC has ceased but PSC will continue to assist in the activation of SSCs for students. To avoid being turned away, students are advised to inform the PSC staff that they would like to <u>activate their SSCs</u>. The minimum top-up value is \$5.</p> <p>Parent may call TransitLink Hotline at 1800-2255 663 for further clarification.</p> <p>P1 students who are on the Financial Assistance Scheme will receive their e vouchers in May 2022.</p>	ST1 and ST3
