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2	<p><u>Values Inculcation – Responsibility</u></p> <p>Good values are best taught and reinforced both in school and at home. Thus, the school implements VIA (Values in Action) at Home as part of efforts in developing positive values and important life skills in our children. A talk on the value of Integrity has been conducted during Class Contact Time on Wednesday, 13 April 2022 and the children are encouraged to practise the value of Responsibility at home too.</p> <p>Please encourage your child to attempt the tasks under the various values listed in “VIA at Home” on page 18 of the Student Handbook. Kindly tick the box next to the task(s) which your child has performed and sign at the bottom of the page if you have yet to do so. Our teachers will be checking the Student Handbook.</p> <p>There is no need to tick every box beside the tasks, just the ones which the children have already carried out. This will give us an idea of how far our children have been able to put these values into practice at home. 4	<p><u>Conversational Chinese and Malay Language Programme (CCM) for Primary 3 and 4 students</u></p> <p>The school will be organizing Conversational Chinese and Malay (CCM) Beginner and Basic Programme for Primary 3 and 4 students in Term 3 and Term 4. The programme aims to enhance interaction among Singaporeans of different races and strengthen social cohesion. In addition, the programme will enable our students to have some grounding in Conversational Chinese or Malay Language so that they can easily pick up the language should they wish to do so in the future. The modules will begin at the primary level and extend through secondary school.</p> <p>All P3 students are eligible to register for the beginner CCM programme. P4 students who attended the Beginner programme in 2021 can advance to the Basic Programme. Students taking Chinese Language will be learning Conversational Malay and students taking Malay Language will be learning Conversational Chinese. Students taking Tamil Language, NTIL or a foreign language may sign up for either Convserational Chinese or Malay Language. The lessons will be conducted in school face-to-face.
