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4	<p><u>Literacy Pro e-books for P5 students</u></p> <p>As part of the school's effort to inculcate a love of reading in our students, the English Language department has arranged for Primary 5 students to subscribe to the Literacy Pro electronic books (e-books). It is a six-month subscription from July to December 2022 at a cost of \$5 per student. The school will fund this pilot programme in 2022. No payment or action is required from the parents this year.</p> <p>This online programme aims to assess, inform and develop students' independent reading. It is individualised to encourage students to read texts matched to their abilities, allowing them to gain valuable reading practice and build comprehension skills.</p> <p>This reading programme will be conducted by your child's English teacher during the reading periods. Your child will receive a User ID and Password from the English Language teacher to access the programme. He/She can read the e-books from any electronic devices in school or at home.
