At the P1&2 levels, non-weighted Class-Level Assessments (CLAs) will be conducted in Term 2, during lesson time, to inform students, teachers and parents of students' learning progress.

Separately, P1&2 Subject Teachers will be reporting on students' attainment levels of the subject-specific Learning Outcomes.

Please also note the following **rules and regulations** for all weighted assessments:

1. Students who are absent during the assessment must produce a valid medical certificate for the day. These students' marks will be pro-rated accordingly. **No marks will be given** for the paper if students are absent without a valid medical certificate.
2. Students who have registered a temperature at or above the trigger temperature, are ill/unwell or are covered by medical certificates on the day of the assessment will not be allowed to sit for it.

	<p>3. Latecomers will not be given additional time. Latecomers who miss the paper entirely will not be allowed to sit for the paper and no marks will be awarded to them.</p> <p>4. There will be no make-up papers (except for Oral Assessments) for students who are absent on assessment days.</p> <p>5. In line with PSLE guidelines, students are not allowed to bring mobile phones or any other electronic devices capable of storing and displaying visual or verbal information into the examination room as this will be construed as attempting to cheat.</p> <p>6. Students who attempt to cheat during an assessment will not be awarded any marks for the paper.</p>
3.	<p><u>P6: Discontinuation of the Secondary School Education Booklet from Year 2023</u></p> <p>The ministry will be discontinuing the Secondary School Education Booklet, “Guiding Your Child in the Next Phase of Learning”, found on the MOE Corporate Website from this year (2023).</p> <p>A survey was conducted late last year on the usage of the booklets, and it was found that there was low awareness, with parents receiving information through sources such as the MOE Corporate website, word-of-mouth and through schools.</p> <p>The Corporate website carries the same information as the booklet, hence there is no need for duplication. The website was also recently updated to be more user-friendly.
