| 4. | <p><u>Measures to Beat the Heat</u></p> <p>In view of the warmer weather, all students would be allowed to continue to report to school in their PE attire till further notice.</p> <p>The school will continue to adopt the following measures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Teachers will continue to look out for our students who may be affected by the warmer weather, especially those with certain pre-existing conditions.Students will be encouraged to drink appropriate amount of fluids and be allowed to drink fluids freely before, during and after activities to prevent and to alleviate exercise-induced heat strain.Schools will minimise physical activities in the outdoors between 10.30am and 3.30pm as the ultraviolet (UV) and heat stress levels are generally high during this period. When it is unavoidable for activities to be carried out during this period, the school will also ensure that additional measures are put in place. <p>Let us continue to remind and guide our children to stay hydrated.</p> |

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| 5. | <p><u>Updated Canteen Menu: Choices of Packet/Bottled Drinks</u></p> <p>Our students' health and well-being are important to us.
