2. Commemoration of Racial Harmony Day

Every year, schools commemorate Racial Harmony Day on 21st July to remind students about the importance of maintaining racial harmony and social cohesion in Singapore. This year's Racial Harmony Day theme, **Singapore: Our Multicultural Mosaic**, focuses on the appreciation of the diverse races and religions that make up our multicultural society, and which contribute to our shared sense of cohesion and harmony.

Our students had a National Education engagement session on racial harmony on Monday, 10 July. On Monday, 17 July, there will be a Racial Harmony Day assembly programme by Sri Warisan Performing Arts titled, "Singapore Festivals and Celebrations through Dance". There will also be a quiz to help students understand more about our various cultures and small tokens will be awarded to the winners. During recess, students can learn more about the various costumes, food, games and songs of our different ethnic groups at the pop-up booths.

Students are encouraged to wear their ethnic costumes, with the usual white socks and black shoes, to school on Monday, 17 July. Please note that they should not be wearing their home clothes or be in T-shirt and jeans on that day.

Should students have PE lessons before recess on that day, they should wear their PE attire to school and change into their costumes during recess. They can then wear their costumes for the rest of the day. Should students have PE lessons after recess on that day, they should wear their costumes to school and change into their PE attire during recess. They should then wear the PE attire for the rest of the day. Students who do not have any ethnic costumes should continue to come to school in their school attire (i.e. school uniform or PE attire).

3. P3&4 Applied Learning Programme (ALP): Focused Skills Training Sessions

The school will be engaging external trainers to provide a one-day Focused Skills Training session for our Primary 3 and Primary 4 students on **Friday, 14 July 2023** and **Friday, 21 July 2023** respectively. The training session will commence at 2.15pm and end at 4.30pm.

Primary 3 students will get to create their own solar-powered cars, while our Primary 4 students will be guided to make their own solar and wind energy-powered fans (as shown below).

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Through the ALP training session, our hope to help our students

1. understand the importance of renewable energy;
2. explore ways to incorporate renewable energy in their daily lives;
3. enhance their fine motor skills through working with identified materials and tools;
4. develop the necessary problem-solving skills and internalise the values of responsibility and resilience.

The ALP training session will also provide an unique opportunity for students to immerse in meaningful learning experiences aligned with Singapore's focus on environmental sustainability. Together, we can nurture environmentally conscious individuals who will contribute to building a greener future.

4. The Big Book Giveaway (BBG) by National Library Board (NLB)


