2. Creating Awareness, Building Resilience: Drug Awareness Talk and Interactive Exhibition on 28 April 2025 (Monday)

As part of our commitment to holistic education and student well-being, we are organizing a **Drug Awareness Talk** and an **interactive exhibition** for our students on 28 April 2025 (Monday). This initiative is designed to equip them with the knowledge and confidence to make safe and informed choices when faced with peer pressure or challenging situations related to drug use.

Aligned with the upcoming **Drug Victims Remembrance Day**, this programme aims to not only educate our students about the dangers of drug abuse, but also to instil empathy and understanding for the broader impact drugs have on families and communities. Through the talk, students will learn about:

- What are drugs and the common illegal substances;
- How drugs affect your body and mind;
- Singapore's strict drug laws; and
- How to say NO to drugs.

There will also be a Drug Awareness Booth set up at the Sheltered Basketball Court. Students can visit the booth during recess and acquaint themselves with the following:

- Discover real-life stories of individuals affected by drugs;
- Learn how drug use impacts not just users, but also their families and the wider community; and
- Access educational materials and prevention tips.

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Singapore has designated every **third Friday of May** as **Drug Victims Remembrance Day** — a meaningful day to *remember the victims of drugs by creating awareness of how family and society, apart from abusers, are harmed by drugs.*

We encourage parents to have open conversations with your child/ren following the talk and exhibition. Together, we can create a strong, informed, and resilient community that stands firm against the dangers of drug abuse.

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3. **P1 and P2 Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Enrichment Programme: Speech and Drama**

The Mother Tongue Languages (MTL) Department has organised a Speech and Drama enrichment programme for all P1 and P2 students. This programme aims to develop students' interest in learning MTL and foster their confidence in expressing themselves via their Mother Tongue language.

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4. **P5 and P6: Use of Approved Mother Tongue Language (MTL) Dictionary**

According to the Singapore Examinations and Assessment Board (SEAB), students are allowed to use approved dictionaries for Composition during PSLE. In addition, students are allowed to use e-dictionaries, if available and approved by SEAB. In alignment with this policy, the school will allow the use of dictionaries for:

- Term 2, P6 Higher Chinese Language and Higher Malay Language Composition Tests;
- Term 3, P5 Higher Chinese Language and Higher Malay Language Composition Tests, and P6 Preliminary Composition Assessments; and
- Term 4, P5 End-of-Year Composition Assessments.
